Growing beans, regardless of type, do not need supplemental fertilizer but they do need consistent irrigation, especially while budding and on into setting pods. Water bean plants with an inch of water per week depending upon weather conditions. Water in the morning so the plants can dry rapidly and avoid fungal disease.

Plant beans after the last frost date in your area, and ideally, wait until the soil is well-warmed (70 to 90 degrees F). Beans should be direct seeded into the soil. Space seeds 1 1/2 inches apart. Space rows 14 to 36 inches apart depending on your equipment.

Peas and beans grow best in a sunny spot with well-drained soil. Planting in raised bed keeps pea seeds from getting soggy while they germinate in cool spring weather and warms the soil for the beans, which you plant later. Peas and beans like moderately moist soil that isn't heavily amended with fertilizer. Here are some other growing tips:

How to Plant Beans. Sow bush bean seeds 1 inch deep and 2 inches apart in rows 18 inches apart. Plant a little

deeper in sandy soils (but not too deep). For pole beans, set up trellises or tepees prior to planting so that the plants' fragile roots are not disturbed. Plant pole bean seeds about 1 inch deep and 3 inches apart.

Plant your beans 1 inch (2.5 cm) deep and 4-6 inches (10-15 cm) apart. If you wish, you can simply make a long furrow about 1 inch (2.5 cm) deep and space your beans out along the furrow, instead of making a series of separate holes.

The most important rule of growing green beans is not to plant the seeds too early. Plant after all danger of frost has passed. Seeds sown too early may rot in cold, damp soil, and the plants need warm weather to thrive. Plant the seeds 1 inch deep and be sure to water the soil immediately after planting and then regularly until they sprout.

If planting pole type beans, be sure to provide a support like a trellis, teepee, or fence. Water the seeds in well and keep moist. Germination should occur between 8-14 days provided temperatures are between 70-80 degrees F. (21-26 C.). Gently thin the seedlings to 6 inches (15 cm.) apart.
